ORDINANCE NO. 341

"Norristown Road Parking Regulation Ordinance"

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WHITPAIN, PART II (GENERAL LEGISLATION), CHAPTER 142 (VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC), SECTION 142-32 (PARKING PROHIBITED AT ALL TIMES IN CERTAIN LOCATIONS) TO ADD A NEW PARKING PROHIBITION ON THE WEST SIDE OF NORRISTOWN ROAD FROM A POINT 142 FEET NORTH OF THE CENTERLINE OF THE NORTHERNMOST INTERSECTION OF HUNTSMAN LANE AND NORRISTOWN ROAD TO A POINT 137 FEET SOUTH OF THE CENTERLINE OF THE SOUTHERNMOST INTERSECTION OF HUNTSMAN LANE AND NORRISTOWN ROAD.

The Board of Supervisors of Whitpain Township does hereby **ENACT** and **ORDAIN**:

SECTION I. - Amendment to Code

The Code of the Township of Whitpain, Part II (General Legislation), Chapter 142 (Vehicles and Traffic), Section 142-32 (Parking Prohibited at All Times in Certain Locations) is hereby amended to add new street parking prohibitions as follows:

| Street | Side | Between |
|-----------------|-------------|---|
| Norristown Road | West | A point 142 feet north of the centerline of the northernmost intersection of Huntsman Lane and Norristown Road to a point 137 feet south of the centerline of the southernmost intersection of Huntsman Land and Norristown Road. |

SECTION II. - Severability

The provisions of this Ordinance are intended to be severable, and if any section, sentence, clause, part or provision hereof shall be held illegal, invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision of the court shall not affect or impair the remaining sections, sentences, clauses, parts or provisions of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared to be the intent of the Board that this Ordinance would have been adopted even if such illegal, invalid or unconstitutional section, sentence, clause, part or provision had not been included herein.

SECTION III. - Failure to Enforce not a Waiver

The failure of the Township to enforce any provision of this Ordinance shall not constitute a waiver by the Township of its rights of future enforcement hereunder.

SECTION IV. - Effective Date

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval as required by the law.

SECTION V. - Repealer

All other ordinances and resolutions or parts thereof insofar as they are inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

NOTICE is hereby given that the Board of Supervisors of Whitpain Township, at its public meeting on October 6, 2015 in the Township Building, 960 Wentz Road, Blue Bell, Pennsylvania, will hold a public hearing on and could vote to adopt Ordinance No. 341 entitled "Norristown Road Parking Regulation Ordinance" amending the Code of the Township of Whitpain, Part II (General Legislation), Chapter 142 (Vehicles and Traffic), Section 142-32 (Parking Prohibited at All Times in Certain Locations) to add a new parking prohibition on the west side of Norristown Road from a point 142 feet north of the centerline of the northernmost intersection of Huntsman Lane and Norristown Road to a point 137 feet south of the centerline of the southernmost intersection of Huntsman Land and Norristown Road.
