AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE TOWNSHIP'S CODE, CHAPTER 53, SECTION 53-4 [SHADE TREE COMMISSION/CREATION] TO INCREASE SHADE TREE COMMISSION MEMBERSHIP FROM THREE TO FIVE TOWNSHIP RESIDENTS

IT IS HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Whitpain Township Board of Supervisors as follows:

SECTION 1. Amendment to the Township's Code, Chapter 53, Section 53-4 [Shade Tree Commission/Creation].

The Township's Code, Chapter 53, Section 53-4 [Shade Tree Commission/Creation] shall be amended to increase Shade Tree Commission membership from three to five Township residents:

§ 53-4 Creation.

The Shade Tree Commission, first created by ordinance adopted on July 21, 1978, is hereby reaffirmed by the Board of Supervisors of Whitpain Township. The Shade Tree Commission shall consist of five members who are residents of the Township of Whitpain and shall serve without compensation. The members of the Shade Tree Commission shall be appointed by the Board of Supervisors of Whitpain Township for a term of five years or until their successors are appointed. Member terms shall be staggered so that no more than one member's term shall expire in any given year. In the event that a vacancy shall occur during the term of any member, his or her successor shall be appointed by the Board of Supervisors of Whitpain Township for the unexpired portion of the term.

SECTION 2. Repeal and Ratification.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith or in conflict with any of the specific terms enacted hereby, to the extent of said inconsistencies or conflicts, are hereby specifically repealed. Any other terms and provisions of the Township's Code unaffected by this Ordinance are hereby reaffirmed and ratified.

SECTION 3. Severability.

Should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase in this Ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, the remainder of the

Ordinance shall not be affected thereby and shall remain in full force and affect, and for this reason the provisions of this Ordinance shall be severable.

SECTION 4. Effective Date.

This Ordinance shall become effective 5 days after enactment.
