WHEREAS, Whitpain Township is Township of the Second Class located in Montgomery County, Pennsylvania; and


WHEREAS, the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation has established the Green Light-Go: Pennsylvania's Municipal Signal Partnership Program for the purpose of funding projects that involve improvements to highway safety and mobility by reducing congestion and improving efficiency of existing traffic signals on state highways.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

1. The Whitpain Township Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the submission of a grant application to the Green Light-Go Program for the purpose of upgrading and improving the traffic signal located at the intersection of Morris Road and School Road/Plymouth Road; Skippack Pike and Union Meeting Road; Skippack Pike and Walton Road; Morris Road and Tournament Drive; and Butler Pike and Norristown Road.
2. Whitpain Township hereby agrees to comply with all Green Light-Go Program requirements.
3. Whitpain Township hereby agrees to provide full payment of the required local match as per program requirements.
